statement

Within a single landscape, a variety of elements intersect and overlap. When distinct elements—nature, the built environment, and human presence—come together, I believe new value and beauty emerge.

Growing up in Tama New Town, a vast modernist planned city, I lived alongside natural ridgelines and the sharp concrete lines of urban architecture. Rooted in this coexistence, my practice explores *awai*—the in-between space where contrasting elements meet.

Through daily observation, I give form to subtle relationships, shifting balances, and the traces of accumulated time using metal and concrete.

Infusing organic shapes and textures into inorganic materials is more than a simple exercise in form-making. It is an attempt to move beyond rigid divisions, allowing new relationships to emerge and opening up different ways of seeing.

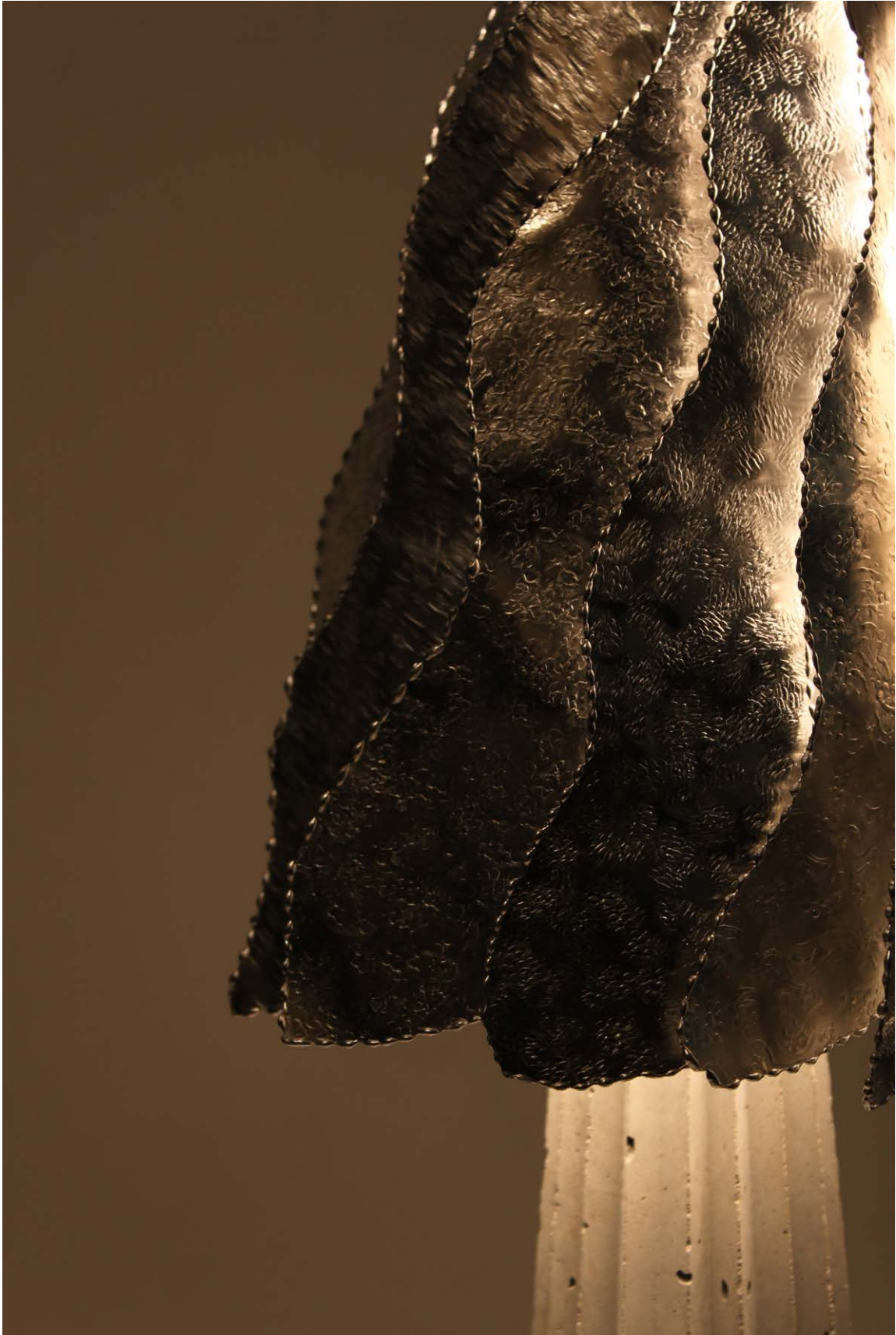

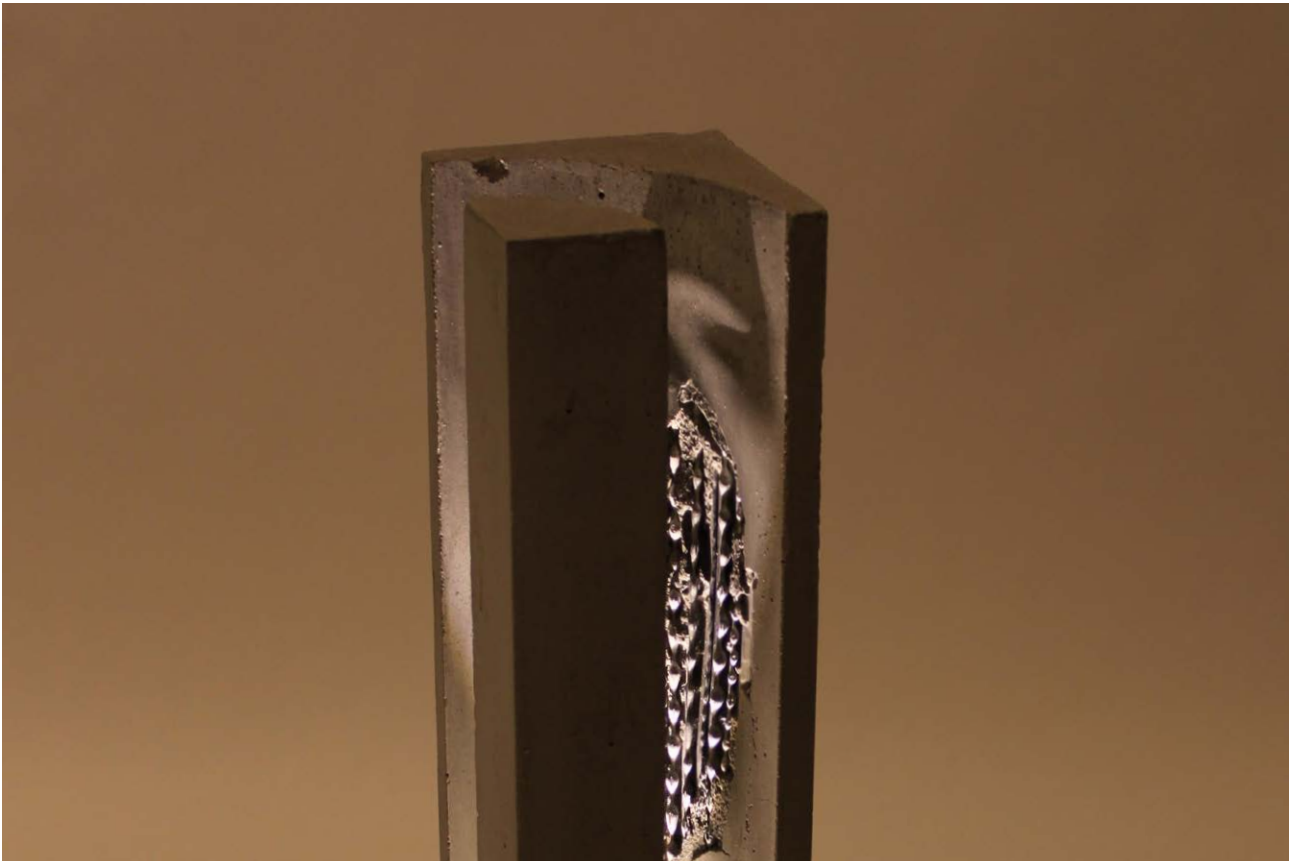

MATERIALS & PROCESS

My creative process begins with an interest in forms, phenomena, and materials encountered in everyday life. Through repeated prototyping, I observe the process behind these forms and transformations, exploring their unique characteristics.

[METAL]

For each piece, I select techniques and materials that harness the inherent rigidity and plasticity of metal. Through processes such as hammering, bending, cutting, and welding, I explore the behavior of the metal and the shifting nuances of its expression.

[ENAMEL]

A technique in which vitreous enamel is fused onto a metal surface. By using transparent rather than opaque glazes, I allow the natural color and texture of the underlying copper to shine through.

Depending on the firing temperature, the copper shifts subtly into shades of red and orange, creating a unique landscape within each piece.

[MORTAR]

I use mortar, a material typically employed in construction, as my primary medium.

Through experimentation with formwork and combinations of aggregates, I explore sculptural forms with organic curves and expressive surfaces.

The smooth, curved form of the mortar was brought to life through a rigorous process of verification and prototyping using paper models.

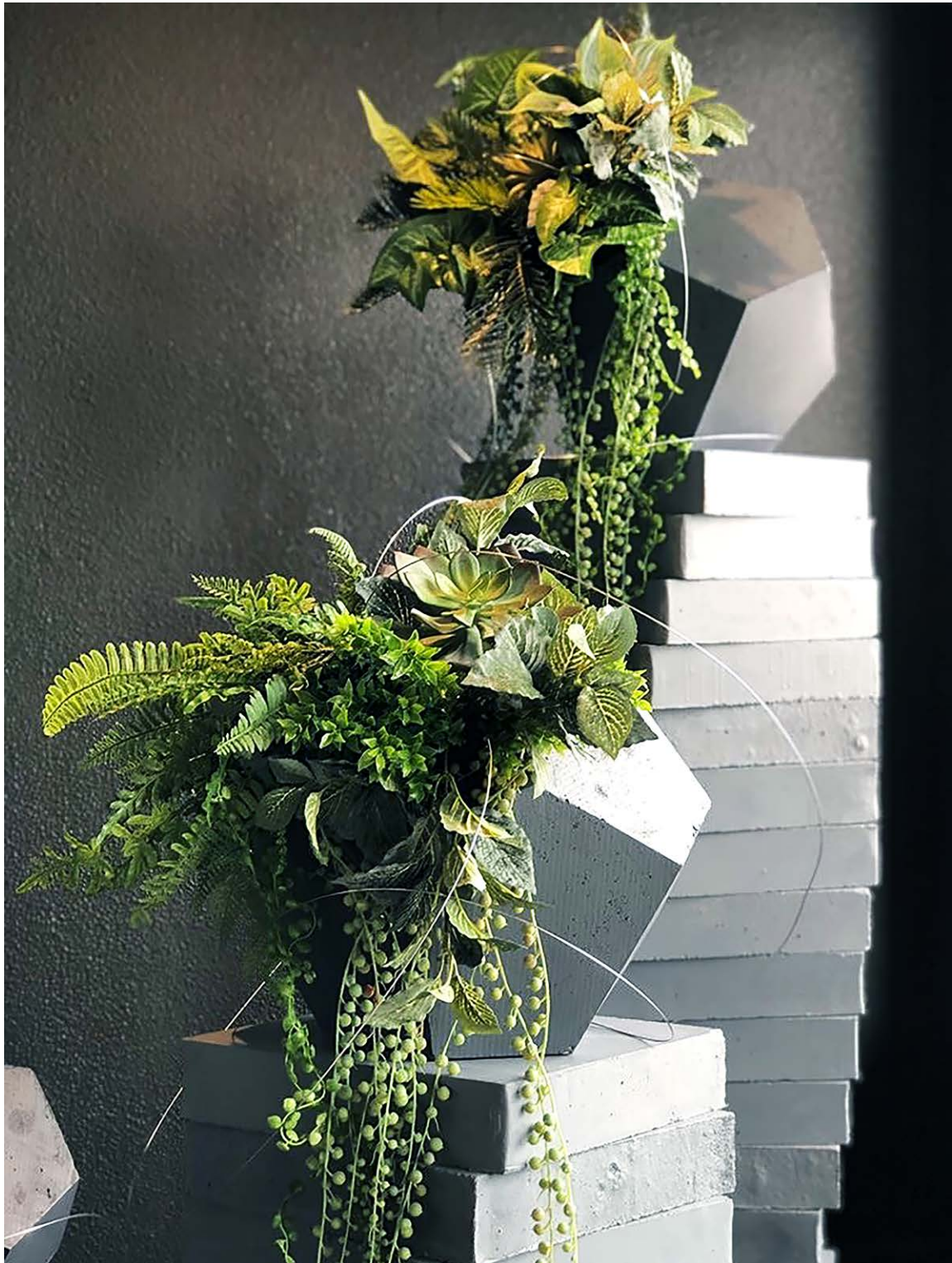
